Exams	Expect a midterm and a final, each worth 50 points.
Projects	You will have 2 projects due near the end of the semester, each worth 50 points.

Readings	You will have a taped reading assignment due periodically. Some of these will be conducted during class time, others may be assigned for outside class. 20 points each.
