COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Textbooks: None. Scene and monologue texts **will** be **chosen** by students, and/or **assigned** by **instructor**

General Course Requirements:

Attendance **is** required at all classes. Students are expected to prepare **material**, and meet with scene **partners**, between classes. **Grading will** be based **on**:

- * Willingness to participate, and do one's best in, all class exercises
- * The quality of individual effort in preparing performances for class
- * Effective **cooperation** with scene **partners**
- * Teamwork with **the** class as a whole **through supporting** and **encouraging** the work of others

Grading:

Instructor will issue each student a written **Evaluation** *at the* end of each week of **class**, grading *the* student's progress so far and **projecting** what *the* **final grade** will be if *the* student **continues** at *the same level of* effort. *The* **final** grade **will** be **one** of *the following-*

- A **Outstanding** teamwork, creativity *and* initiative
- B Good and *generally* consistent **effort**, creativity **and** teamwork
- C Average grade, representing adequate creative effort and teamwork
- D Work of below-average quality, bat still passing
- F Failure to participate in **required course** work or engage in **teamwork**, OR **failure** to withdraw **officially** from the course
- W Official withdrawal from the course
- I **Incomplete.** This grade **means** that the **student has** been **unable**, for a valid reason, *to complete* the course work on the **ass ed** schedule. If the student wishes to complete the course and receive *another* grade, he or she must **sign** a contract with **the instructor, specifying** the completion requirements and **deadlines**.

Fairy tales. 12/29 (Wed) Conflict of Will, Stage 3: Deadly Secrets (One's own). Advanced 12/30 (Thu) scene blocking. Second Evaluation. Monologues. 1/3 (Mon) Solo songs. Music improvisations. 1/5 (Wed) Conflict of Will, Stage 4: Deadly Secrets (About partner) and 1/7 (Fri)
