- give examples of different views of how art should be taught
- use his or her own art as a classroom resource

- know how to provide developmentally appropriate art experiences for children in the various preschool and elementary grade levels
- continue to build confidence in the artist within oneself
- recognize his or her growing visual aesthetic awareness
- encourage children to share their feelings and experiences through art.
