Course Objectives:

In this course you will have the opportunity to improve your listening and speaking skills in preparation for immersion into the regular academic environment.

- Students will improve their listening comprehension ability through the use of recorded audio material containing everyday language spoken by native speakers of English in various settings.
- 2) The use of prerecorded videotapes will help the students' listening comprehension ability in academic settings.
- 3) Through small group and class discussions, students will have the opportunity to share their own views and opinions on topics presented in class.
- 4) Through individual oral presentations, the students will be able to practice Speaking in front of an audience.

Use of English Inside and Outside the Classroom:

The exclusive use of English may require an extra effort but it will give practice and confidence to the student who is using it. Moreover, it will help the people around the student feel comfortable. This is very important for all of us in an international setting like Chaminade
