#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

"American can remember World Series games and records; but they know little of the world's people and how they came to be what they are." ---a Japanese university professor

The story of the human race on the planet from earliest times until the 16th Century is both fascinating and vital. As early humans began to form groups, tribes, and eventually "nations," they sought safety, abilities to grow and store food, religious beliefs and practices and those to lead such, and power. Eventually empires emerged, (larger than a nation, an empire is control of other and far-flung peoples by a different people or nation,) and fell. Early ideas of all the world's great religions and disciples and philosophies and practices were in place by the year 1500 A.D. Notions of power, control, order, democracy, monarchies, and republics were born before the birth of Jesus! Human history is not an orderly progression from "darkness" to order and "light;" but neither is it totally chaotic and irrelevent to the present. WORLD CIVILIZATION, rather than earlier limited views oof WESTERN CIVILIZATION (still taught at some universities!), leads to recognizing there is one humanity with many variations. AFTER  $1500\ AD$ the European World began to impact upon the rest of the world, and great exchanges occurred between regions. BEFORE 1500 AD the world's regions developed largely independently of each other but with important contacts.

THE CLASS "TERM"---THEY ARE NOT LIKELY TO BE "HAPPY" IF HELD LATER!!!


