Description: A survey of the battles of major military commanders from the Classical period through the 2d World War. Each class will include battles of selected commanders to be analyzed in conjunction with the Commander's background and milieu. In some instances, such as the 1940 German drive to the sea in France, an entire campaign will be examined.

Objectives: To examine the impact of leadership on the development of military strategty and tactics during the proposed time period. Also to be included is the influence of the tecnological advances that occur during the era. In doing so it is hoped that the student will gain an appreciation for the complexities of warfare, and perhaps as a corollary an insight into the requirements of leadership in general.

Grading Criterior: Each student will be assigned a battle to analyze in a term paper, to include, a diagram, written description, and the logistical concerns that influenced decisions and operations. There will also be two examinations, consisting of multiple choice, and essay questions.

Texts & Reading Assignments:

Text: Robert L. O'Connell, Of Arms and Men.

In addition it is planned to provide handouts for each class subject. For example, a chapter in a biography of the Duke of Marlborough that analyzed the battle of Blenheim.
