Course Description;

Japanese 201, Intermediate Japanese, is designed for students who have a basic knowledge of Japanese and speaking skills. In this course, although the students will learn some of the important grammatical patterns, the spoken language will be more emphasized. Classes meet three times a week and daily attendance and participation are expected.

Objectives:

- (1) To learn structural patterns of the Japanese language, and to practice using them in everyday situations.
- (2) To further develop speaking and listening skills in general situation.
- (3) To develop speaking skills for specific situations.
- (4) To develop reading skills and learn basic kanji characters.

Requirements:

- (1) Watching Videos: During the semester each students will watch at least 5 Japanese videos at home. Each students must use the sign up sheet when taking out and when returning the videos.
- (2) An presentation will be assigned at the end of the semester. (15 min.)
- (3) Attendance will be taken each day. Five absences will be considered as one grade down.

Quizzes and Exams:

There will be a quiz after each lesson and longer midterm and final examinations.
