Course Description:

Japanese 206, Intermediate Japanese, is designed for students who have a basic knowledge of Japanese, including speaking skills and writing with hiragana & katakana. This course will teach more grammatical patterns and vocabulary to further develop the students' communicative abilities. Also 100 - 150 Kanji will be instructed during this course.

Objectives:

- (1) to learn structual patterns of the Japanese language, and to practice using them in every day situations.
- (2) To further develop speaking, listening and reading skills.
- (3) To learn basic kanji characters.

Requirements:

- (1) Listening tapes: mandatory
- (2) Interview: At the end of the semester, the instructor will interview each student in Japanese.
- (3) Attendance will be taken each day. <u>Five unexcused absences will lower your</u> grades by one letter grade.
