**Project/Class Presentation**

Your typed report will include this information as well as, your impression of the facility or agency and what you learned or gained from your visit or research.

**Agency Selection**

Agency selection will be on a first come; first serve basis. Agency selection will be accomplished by filling out the attached 3x5 card.
