ASSIGNMENTS

1. Journal writings (6)

Please staple together 6 (standard size) pieces of lined notebook paper - no binder. This will be your 6 pg. Journal. Each journal writing will be limited to (1) one handwritten page and each writing will connect with a chapter that we are studying from the text. You may not write on the back side of the paper. The entries will be in ink. The purpose of the assignment is to help you personalize the readings.

Each writing will be your personal adolescent experience in relation to a topic posed from the chapter.

writing #1: My experience of the family process

writing #2: The importance of my friends

writing #3: What I liked/or disliked about school

writing #4: Self understanding (mine) in high school

writing # 5: My sexual education writing #6: My developing values

These writings will be graded on depth of thought, relationship to the text and writing skills. **NO LATE WRITINGS ACCEPTED**

2. Quizzes (3) will be short answer and essay.

3. Projects (2) (NO LATE PAPERS ACCEPTED)

- 1. Feb. 23 on issue of choice from Ch. 6-8.
- 2. Mar. 18 on sexuality (Ch. 11 & Ch. 12).

<u>Project #1</u> is taken from the chapters on Families, Peers and Schools. You may select any <u>one</u> of the 3 issues listed below and create a 5 pg. typed, double-spaced paper which will include a bibliography. Your opinion will also be included and defended.

- 1. (Ch. 6) Family stability in a changing society.
- 2. (Ch. 7) Friendships role in development.
- 3. (Ch. 8) What kinds of schools help adolescents thrive.

Project #2 is taken from the chapters on gender development and sexuality. You will combine research with interview and write a 5 page paper on "past and present adolescent gender roles/sexuality- is this called 'progress'" your paper will be typed, double-spaced.

- 4. Final This will be taken from Ch 15 & 16. Discussed in class at a later date.
- 5. Assignment from the <u>Career Center</u> due April 15. You will make an appointment (on your own) to visit the Career Center & discuss with one of the counselors your interests, desire and career potential. You will take (& have scored) the Myers-Briggs Personality inventory. You will need to have taken this measurement <u>prior</u> to your meeting with the counselor as you will need to discuss the measurement at the time of your appt. All of this must be <u>completed by April 15</u> as we will be using your personal career test/ & understanding in order to do a Reflective writing in class.
