Course Description

Adolescent Development will provide an intensive study of the physical, cognitive, and social/emotional development of the adolescent. Through the use of website activities, reading, and writing, students will have an opportunity to explore theoretical approaches and current issues related to adolescent development from a multidisciplinary and cross-cultural perspective with a focus on promoting optimal development.
