Course Description: PSY 424 Abnormal Psychology (3) Study of the development Treatment, and prevention of psychological disorders. Presentation of the dynamics of abnormal behavior from a biological, psychological, and socio-cultural context. Current research and assessment tools will also be covered. Offered annually, Prereq: PSY 101.

Required Text: Fundamentals of Abnormal Psychology, 3rd ed. by Ronald J Comer.

Method of Evaluation: This is a 100 point class. Extra credit is possible.

Description of Assignments:

Mature Scholarship: Attendance at class OR if this is not possible due to a specific circumstance then communicate with instructor/team members with regard to your contribution responsibilities. Be tolerant to discussions of differing opinions. Share class time so that all classmates have opportunities for self-expression. Participate with respect. Complete assignments in a timely manner.

Weekly Class Experiential Exercises: These are opportunities provided by the professor to learn the practical realities of the continuum of behavior: ranging from norm to outside of the norm.

Weekly Team Exercises: Teams will form. Professor will provide a Case Study to each team. Team will diagnose, design treatment plans, discuss ramifications of case. Team will create a unique way to present their case to the class on the final day of class. Professor will check-in with each team on a weekly basis to determine progress of work.

Mid-term Paper: Identify a topic of interest in the field of abnormal psychology. Clear this topic with the professor. Craft a paper which describes the disorder, offer case examples, traditional treatments, and your own recommendations/ideas about the etiology, treatment, and societal effects of the disorder. Use APA format.

Team Presentation of Case Study: Each team will present their case study to the class. Presentation style is at the discretion of the team. However, it is expected that the cases be presented with respect and dignity. Team members are graded individually, however part of the individual grade is earned by cooperative work with other team members. Length of presentation is 30-40 minutes.
