## Course objectives

To continue the development of a basic competency in speaking, listening, writing and reading; to expand the knowledge base of Hispanic culture. Upon successful completion of the course, students will be able to talk about weather, food, vacation, likes and dislikes, holidays, emotions, free time, household chores and more. New tense forms such as the present progressive, the Preterite and Imperfect will also be introduced. Students, furthermore, will study the geographic locations of Spain and/or Latin America as well as their capitals and/or major cities and regions. Geographical material will be tested.

## Course description

Quiz/Chapter Exams/Final Exam

The quiz, chapter exams and the final exam need to be taken on the day indicated in the syllabus or stipulated by the instructor. Everything covered in class may be tested. In case of emergency, please contact your instructor before the test day. Otherwise, no make-ups will be given. Written proof of your emergency is required. (See attachment)

#### **Oral Exams**

A brief oral conversation will be part of each chapter exam. The student will be given a situation and will role-play with the instructor. No written notes must be taken for this part of the chapter exams. Failure to comply with this stipulation will result in zero points for the particular section.

## **Cultural Segments**

Purpose: To expand our knowledge about Spanish and Hispanic cultures and geography. These segments may include videos, photos and/or other material about one or more Spanish-speaking countries and/or regions. The information discussed in class will be tested in English or Spanish on quizzes and/or the final exam.

#### Homework

The homework (e.g. workbook, lab manual, short compositions, handouts etc.) may vary in points and are due on the day indicated by your instructor. Some inclass activities (i.e. group work) may be graded as well. Your <a href="homework assignments">homework assignments will be accepted only one class period late, however, will be subjected to a 25% point deduction from the maximum points available for the particular assignment. Both homework and in-class assignments will be counted together for the maximum points available and will be averaged if the maximum points are not reached by the end of the semester.

#### Preparation/Participation

Classes will be conducted primarily in Spanish so that you may process a maximum amount of the target language either mentally or otherwise. Please DO NOT be afraid to make mistakes! Your participation points are not based on how grammatically correct you are, but if you make a sincere effort to learn and practice. Don't be afraid to volunteer or ask questions either, since most likely others have similar questions. Moreover, as a general rule, university courses require 1 - 2 hours of study per hour of class instruction. To gain the maximum benefit from this class, please come fully prepared. If you have to miss class, you are also responsible to be fully prepared by the next class period.
