Course Goals

This course will build on grammar concepts studied in 201 for further understanding as well as develop competency in speaking, listening, reading and writing.

**Textbook** 

Cubillos, Jorge H. Siempre adelante (text, workbook and lab manual)

Students should also have a Spanish-English dictionary.

Preparation/Participation

Students will be evaluated on their preparation and active participation in the course. Students should come to class fully prepared with homework completed. Courses will be conducted in Spanish. Study the assignments and bring any questions to class with you.

Attendance

It is important to attend all classes since a major goal of this course is to develop accurate communicative ability. If you miss a class, get the assignment from a classmate or your instructor and come prepared to the next class. 3 absences will be excused; thereafter your final grade will be lowered 2 points per absence. If you are ill, a doctor's note is required the day you return to class in order to be excused. If you are attending a meeting/conference/game and it requires you to miss class, you must notify your instructor in advance and all homework must be completed. Once you have a total of 10 or more absences you will NOT be allowed to take the final exam.

Homework/Daily Quiz

Homework will be assigned daily. Quizzes will be based on the homework or workbook assignments. Your instructor may collect assignments to help assess daily preparation. Come prepared to avoid losing points on both preparation and daily quizzes. Quizzes will be given at the beginning of each class period and **NO MAKEUPS** are permitted. You may speak to your instructor in English before and after class, otherwise you are expected to attempt to communicate in Spanish throughout the class period. **NO LATE HOMEWORK WILL BE ACCEPTED.** 

Compositions

You will write two compositions during the semester on topics related to the chapters covered. The compositions you develop will help you write better essays on the exams. You will be given more information.

### Oral assessments

Students will present a prepared dialogue in pairs in class as scheduled. More information will be given later.

# **Journals**

Students are expected to practice writing Spanish in a journal that will be periodically collected by the instructor. The journal is a daily 10-minute free write such that the student may choose any topic to write about. A grade will not be given based on grammatical correctness, however a grade will be given for completion of the assignment. Further details will be given.

#### Workbook

The workbook should be completed at home once the lesson has been covered in class. The student is responsible for correcting the workbook in a different color ink as the answers are included in the back. Workbooks will be handed in (corrected) the day of the chapter tests (see calendar for dates).

## Chapter Tests and Final Exam

At the end of each chapter, there will be a chapter exam covering the material studied. See calendar for dates.

The final exam will be cumulative. See calendar for date and time.

There are <u>NO MAKEUPS</u> for any exams. However, in the event of an illness/emergency, you must contact the instructor <u>BEFORE</u> the class/exam and written proof of the illness/emergency must be presented in order to be able to take the test/exam.
