Course Description:

Operations Management includes a survey of production and operational procedures, an overview of total quality management, methods of improvement, production layout flow and operations scheduling.

Course Method:

This course will include lectures, class discussions, in-class exercises, case studies, and examinations. Some outside class work may be required. Study groups will be established.

Grading:

Performance evaluation will be based on a grading system containing two essential elements: Individual and Group performance. Final marks will be determined by a percentage of these two elements. Percentages will be set the first morning of class using the following criteria: Individual..80-60%, Group..20-40%

Grades will be made up of the following:

Class participation (10 points each class).....100

In class group work (4 @ 25 points each)100

Homework... 3 assignments @25 points each 75
